This past Sunday, March 29, was such a pretty day, we thought we would go for a drive with the top down to the two 2015 Texas Miata Challenge locations just south of the DFW area. These are the Willie Nelson Abbott Grocery Store in Abbott, TX, and the Burial site and Monument for Elizabeth Crockett at Acton Cemetery in Acton, TX.

We left Dallas heading south on I-35E.

We left I-35E at exit 408 where we headed south on hwy 77.

We had a pleasant drive through Waxahachie, Forreston, and Italy.

At Milford we headed south on Hwy 308.

We drove Hwy 308 through Mertens.

At Irene (actually just before Irene), we turned west on Hwy 1946. This was a good country drive on a curvy road.

At Bynum, we turned south on Hwy 171 for about 1/2 mile then turned west on Hwy 1242.

Hwy 1242 took us to the Abbott Cash Grocery, where the friendly lady made us some good ham and cheese sandwiches for lunch.

The building is owned by Willie Nelson, and she said that Willie had requested that the "Willie" road signs be removed, along with other "Willie" signs.

After the lunch break, we got back on I-35 heading north.

We exited I-35 at 368A for Hwy 171 going west.

We drove on Hwy 171 through Covington and into Cleburne. This is a fun road with lots of hills and turns.

After going through the main part of Cleburne, we turned west on Hwy 4.

Hwy 4 eventually crossed U.S. 67. Hwy 4 is another fun hilly and curvy road.

Just as we were coming into Acton, Hwy 4 turned right and the cemetery is on the left. It was easy to see the Elizabeth Crockett memorial; it's the tallest one in the cemetery.

Where we could park Pepper (our Miata), the statue was way in the background. So we set up the tripod and got a picture using telephoto to make the statue look bigger.

We left Acton on Hwy 4, which became Hwy 167 north.

Hwy 167 intersects with U.S. 377. So we headed home on 377.

It was quite a pleasant drive. Of course we forgot the sunscreen, so had some red skin Sunday evening.

Terrie and I are now halfway through the 2015 Miata Challenge, and looking forward to the Roundup in a few weeks and future drives to south Texas for more challenge sites.



Summer is only a few months away. That means road trips on hot, sunny days, and what's better when you return home than a nice bowl of home-made ice cream?

So, with no further ado, here is a recipe that my father developed after we moved to a savage land to the north where Blue Bell ™ was not available. I have a six-quart freezer, so that's the recipe I'll share. After that I'll list modifications for a 4 quart freezer.

#### Ingredients:

3 cups sugar

6 eggs

2 cans Eagle brand sweetened condensed milk

2 cans Pet evaporated milk

½ teaspoon salt

1 tablespoon vanilla extract

1 quart heavy cream

Whole milk to fill the tank to the fill line.

#### Directions

Mix the first five ingredients until thoroughly blended.

Optional step 1: Cook the mixture over low heat to no more than 140 degrees for approximately 10 minutes. This will slightly coagulate the eggs, resulting in a more custard-like texture.

Optional step 2: Chill the mixture in the refrigerator. This will speed the freezing process, resulting in a smoother texture.

Add the vanilla extract.

Pour the mixture and cream into the freezer tank. Fill to the freezer fill line with whole milk. Freeze per your machine's instructions. For longer term storage, I recommend dividing the ice cream into 1-quart containers. This allows for the addition of other flavors (such as peppermint and Andes Mint chunks), and reduces the amount of melt-and-refreeze when you serve the ice cream.

#### For a four-quart freezer:

2 cups sugar

4 eggs

1 can Eagle brand sweetened condensed milk

1 can Pet evaporated milk

¼ teaspoon salt

2 teaspoons vanilla extract

1 pint heavy cream

Mugs are available for about \$12, and shirts are available for around \$10-15. Contact Richard for details.


