New Business

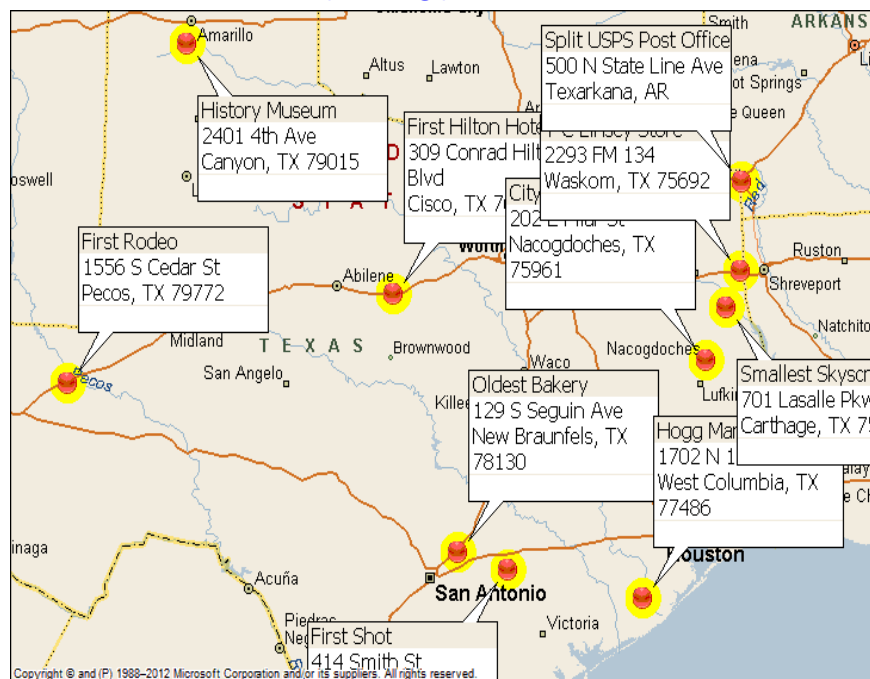
